Ash Wednesday Service

February 17, 2010 at 6:30 PM

I missed all of you on Sunday. I hope that everyone has power once again as I know that many of you have been without it. The good news is that the church once again has power. The electricity came back on at the church sometime late Sunday evening.

This Wednesday night at 7:00 p.m., we will be having our Ash Wednesday Service (Lord willing and no snow). I hope that all of you will be present at this service. We will be offering the imposition of ashes during our worship on Wednesday night. Ash Wednesday gets its name from the practice of placing ashes on the foreheads of the faithful as a sign of repentance. The ashes used are gathered after the Palm Crosses from the previous year's [Palm Sunday](#) are burned. In the liturgical practice of most churches, the ashes are mixed with the oil prior to the imposition of ashes.

During this season on Lent, I hope that you are remembering to take time to pray for our church every day. I think that God is doing trying to do a "new thing" here at First Christian, and we need to **LISTEN** to God's voice during our prayers to be able to determine where God is calling our church to go. **God is still speaking---are you listening?** God told Jesus' disciples that accompanied Him during His transfiguration to "Listen to Him (Jesus)". Those are good words for each of us to live by today.

Lent is a time for us all to reflect upon our life and our walk with Christ. Is your relationship with the Lord where you would like it to be? If not, can you commit to becoming more disciplined by spending time daily with your

Bible and in prayer? How are you going to deepen your faith understanding during the 40 days of Lent? I hope one way you will do that is to participate in our Lenten Study. **The study will be at 7:00 p.m. with a light dinner at 6:30 p.m. The night of the study is to be determined.** We will be studying Spiritual Disciplines as a way to deepen our faith walk with Christ. Spiritual Disciplines include prayer, meditation, fasting, reading scriptures, etc.

You might wonder why I keep harping on prayer. It is because I am sure that prayer change things—it changes relationships, it changes people, and it can therefore change churches. Prayer helps us to keep focused on God. Prayer helps us to unite as the "Body of Christ". Prayer helps us to keep the Evil One from using our disagreements as a way to divide us. Prayer allows us to forgive and to be forgiven.

Try to spend this season of Lent reflecting on your faith journey. Look for ways that you can deepen your walk with Christ. Continue to pray daily for our church and for its members. Pray for those who are in need of healing: Ab, Anna, Bob B, Bob K, Nancy and S.C. And continue to hold Laura in your prayers as she continues to look for employment. I look forward to seeing each of you in worship this Sunday as we continue our journey. I covet your continuing prayers for my ministry with you.

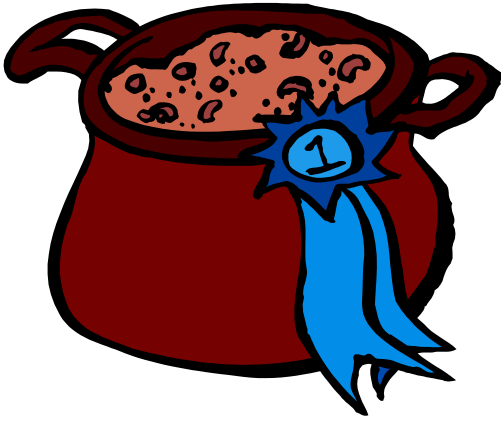
